On 06/13/2019 defendant was stopped roadside at approximately 01:25am on his bicycle as a suspicious person. Defendant had with him a white garbage bag full of what he identified as deflated pool floats. In the past 7 months, the city of Palm Bay has been plagued with burglaries in which the suspect cuts the screen or otherwise enters a victim's back pool deck area and steals only pool floats. There have been an estimated 13 reports made in this time frame. Multiple victims indicated that they had been burglarized several times by this person but only reported them on the second or third burglary of their floats.

Defendant was read his Miranda warnings and agreed to speak with me without an attorney. Defendant stated essentially the following about this case: that he has burglarized several houses and took many floats but does remember burglarizing this house as he took a watermelon float from here. Defendant denied coming back to this house and stealing multiple pool floats however the victim stated that this watermelon float was the third float to be taken from her house. Defendant said he has kept this float at a vacant house that is directly across the street from where he lives, 1810 Radcliff St. SE Palm Bay. Defendant drove us to this vacant house and an estimated 75 pool floats were located here. Defendant stated that he sexually gratifies himself with the floats and does this instead of raping women.

Victim in this case reported this burglary on 11/27/2018 and does wish to pursue charges. She stated she caught this burglary on her surveillance camera and the defendant matches the suspect in the video.
