**COMPLAINT**

COMES NOW the Plaintiff, DAVID AUSTIN GAY, by and through undersigned counsel, and hereby sues and files this Complaint against WAYNE IVEY, in his individual capacity and in his official capacity as Sheriff of Brevard County, Florida and BREVARD COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE. Plaintiff alleges as follows:

**GENERAL ALLEGATIONS**

1. This action arises from the false and defamatory statements that DAVID AUSTIN GAY was a "fugitive" in Sheriff WAYNE IVEY's and BREVARD COUNTY SHERIFF's OFFICE's 'Wheel of Fugitive' videos dated January 26, February 2, February 9 and February 23, 2021.
2. This is an action for damages in excess of \$50,000.
3. The events giving rise to this cause of action occurred and accrued in Brevard County, Florida.
4. At all times relevant hereto, Plaintiff DAVID AUSTIN GAY (hereinafter, Mr. GAY) was over the age of 18 years old and a resident of Brevard County, Florida.

5. At all times relevant hereto, Defendant WAYNE IVEY (hereinafter, IVEY) was the Sheriff for the citizens of Brevard County, Florida whose oversight duties included management of the Brevard County Jail and the Brevard County Sheriff's Office with several offices located throughout Brevard County including 340 Gus Hipp Blvd, Rockledge, Florida 32955.
6. At all times relevant hereto, Defendant BREVARD COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE (hereinafter, BCSO) was the county law enforcement agency for the citizens of Brevard County, Florida, managed the Brevard County Jail, and had several offices located throughout Brevard County including 340 Gus Hipp Blvd, Rockledge, Florida 32955.
7. Venue is proper in this Court pursuant to §47.011 and §48.193 of the Florida Statutes.
8. In compliance with §768.28, Fla. Stat., DAVID GAY has sent a pre-suit notice of claim to WAYNE IVEY, c/o Brevard County Sheriff's Office, BREVARD COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE, and to the Florida Department of Financial Services.

### **FACTS**

9. At all times relevant hereto, IVEY and BCSO published on the internet a promotional social media show titled 'Wheel of Fugitive' that is similar to the television game show 'Wheel of Fortune.' On Facebook, the show's tag line proclaims, "It's time for everyone's favorite *fugitive from justice* show...Wheel of Fugitive!!" (Emphasis added.) The 'wheel' spins to rock and roll music featuring "Today's Wheel participants" showing the names and photos of up to ten alleged "fugitives." IVEY introduces himself and focuses on the person selected by the wheel.
10. In each video, IVEY encourages citizens to help capture the alleged fugitives. For example, on January 26, 2021, IVEY stated that he "loves" how citizens help get criminals off the street so "they cannot hurt anyone else" and that he has ten fugitives on the wheel

who “need to find their way to the Brevard County Jail.” In all episodes, IVEY tells the audience that all ten persons on the wheel are fugitives with reservations at the Brevard County Jail and that he needs the public’s help to get them to the jail.

11. On January 26, 2021, IVEY and/ or BCSO published a ‘Wheel of Fugitive’ episode that included Mr. GAY’s name and photo and stated he was a fugitive.
12. On January 26, 2021, DAVID AUSTIN GAY was in the Brevard County Jail.
13. Mr. GAY was in jail for allegedly violating his probation after being arrested for a second case that was ultimately dismissed.
14. Mr. GAY had been on probation in Brevard County, Florida case number 2018-CF-052441. [05-2018-CF-052441-A, Doc. 53.]
15. At his sentencing on November 2, 2020, Mr. GAY’s scoresheet (summary of criminal history) showed that he had no prior criminal history. [Doc. 52.]
16. Mr. GAY was sentenced to a withhold of adjudication (not a conviction) and three years of probation. [Doc. 55.]
17. After sentencing, Mr. GAY reported to probation on November 3, December 8 and December 18, 2020.
18. On December 20, 2020, IVEY and/ or BCSO took custody of GAY after he was arrested for a misdemeanor in a second case charging Domestic Battery in Brevard County Case No. 05-2020-MM-054563-A.
19. The arrest affidavit alleged that Mr. GAY committed Domestic Battery because he believed his father “was in a physical altercation with [his] mother.” [2020-MM-054563, Doc. 1.]
20. On December 21, 2020, Mr. GAY posted bond on the second case and was released from custody.
21. Upon release, Mr. GAY called his probation officer, spoke to her on the phone and told her

that he had been arrested. He specifically asked if he had any other warrants and was told that he did not.

22. On December 23, 2021, Mr. GAY's probation officer filed a violation of probation report in the first case and requested a warrant. [2018-CF-052441, Doc. 62 & 63.] The only basis for the violation report was that Mr. GAY had been arrested in the second case.
23. On December 31, 2020, a warrant was signed for Mr. GAY's arrest in the first case based on the violation of probation for his arrest in the second case. [2018-CF-052441, Doc. 64.]
24. On January 4, 2021, the violation of probation warrant was filed in the court system. [2018-CF-052441, Doc. 64.]
25. On January 19, 2021, the Brevard County State Attorney's Office filed a Notice of No Information and dismissed the second case alleging that Mr. GAY had committed battery against his father. [20-MM-054562, Doc. 12.]
26. However, the violation of probation in the first case, 05-2018-CF-052441-A, was not dismissed and the warrant remained in effect.
27. On January 25, 2021, probation called Mr. GAY on the number he had previously provided them. Probation told him they had a piece of paper he needed to sign and that an officer would come to his location for his signature. Mr. GAY was not at home so he gave the address where he was located and waited for probation to arrive.
28. Instead, on the same day, January 25, 2021, Brevard County Sheriff's Deputy Aziz Ghaw arrived at the address and Mr. GAY was taken into custody without incident on the warrant that alleged he had violated his probation in the first case by being arrested in the now-dismissed second case.
29. After he was incarcerated at the Brevard County Jail, Mr. GAY's name and photo was on the 'Wheel of Fugitive' episode published January 26, 2021.

30. On February 2, 2021, IVEY and/ or BCSO published another ‘Wheel of Fugitive’ episode that included Mr. GAY’s name and photo and stated he was a fugitive.
31. On February 2, 2021, Mr. GAY was incarcerated at the Brevard County Jail.
32. On February 9, 2021, IVEY and/ or BCSO published a third ‘Wheel of Fugitive’ episode that included Mr. GAY’s name and photo and stated he was a fugitive.
33. On February 9, 2021, Mr. GAY was incarcerated at the Brevard County Jail.
34. On February 22, 2021, Mr. GAY pleaded to violating his probation by being arrested for domestic battery in 05-2021-MM-XXXX-A, even though that charge had been previously dismissed on January 19, 2021. [2018-CF-052441, Doc. 74.]
35. Again, Mr. GAY’s sentencing scoresheet showed no prior criminal history. [2018-CF-052241, Doc. 75.]
36. The sentencing court reinstated Mr. GAY’s probation under the “same terms and conditions as previously imposed” and allowed him to maintain a withhold of adjudication so that he did not become a convicted felon. [2018-CF-052442, Doc. 78.]
37. On the same day, February 22, 2021, Mr. GAY was released from custody.
38. On February 23, 2021, IVEY and/ or BCSO published a fourth ‘Wheel of Fugitive’ episode that included Mr. GAY’s name and photo and stated he was a fugitive.
39. On February 23, 2021, Mr. GAY had been lawfully released from the Brevard County Jail.
40. On February 24, 2021, Mr. GAY reported to probation.
41. After his release, Mr. GAY was hired for a new job. As he drove to his first day of work, his new employer informed him by phone to not bother showing up as he had seen Mr. GAY in IVEY and/ or BCSO’s ‘Wheel of Fugitive’ videos; therefore losing his job.
42. After learning he was featured on IVEY and/ or BCSO’s ‘Wheel of Fugitive’ videos, Mr. GAY experienced emotional distress including, but not limited to, depression and anxiety.

Mr. GAY stayed in his home as much as possible out of fear that the public and/ or the police would stop, harass, verbally and physically threaten, or arrest him.

43. In many ‘Wheel of Fugitive’ episodes, IVEY and/ or BCSO included several other people who did not have outstanding warrants. For example, in the February 23, 2021 episode, Mr. GAY had been in jail 28 days and five other people were in custody or otherwise had their warrants resolved ranging from 13 to 34 days prior to publication. (See Attachment.)
44. Coincidentally, the wheel never landed on Mr. GAY or any other person who did not have an active warrant. The wheel always landed on a person who had an outstanding warrant on the date the ‘Wheel of Fugitive’ episode was published. (See Attachment.)
45. A ‘fugitive’ is defined by Black’s Law Dictionary as:

Fugitive. 1. Someone who flees or escapes; a refugee. 2. A criminal suspect or a witness in a criminal case who flees, evades, or escapes arrest, prosecution, imprisonment, service of process or the giving of testimony, esp. by fleeing the jurisdiction or by hiding. *See* 18 USCA § 1073. – Also termed (in sense 2) *fugitive from justice*.” *Black’s Law Dictionary* (11<sup>th</sup> ed. 2019).

**COUNT 1 –DEFAMATION**  
**AGAINST WAYNE IVEY**  
**(January 26, 2021)**

46. Mr. GAY adopts by reference, as if fully and completely set forth in this Count, paragraphs 1 through 45 herein.
47. STATEMENT OF FACT. On January 26, 2021, IVEY made a statement fact regarding Mr. GAY - to wit, that Mr. GAY was a “fugitive” – by use of Mr. GAY’s name and image and through written and verbal statements during an episode of IVEY and/ or BCSO’s ‘Wheel of Fugitive’ show.
48. PUBLICATION. On January 26, 2021, IVEY published or caused to be published the ‘Wheel of Fugitive’ episode depicting Mr. GAY to the general public on the internet through several outlets including YouTube and Facebook.

49. FALSITY. IVEY's statement(s) that Mr. GAY was a "fugitive" in the 'Wheel of Fugitive' episode of January 26, 2021 was demonstratively false because Mr. GAY was in custody of the Brevard County Jail on January 26, 2021.
50. FALSITY. IVEY's statement(s) that Mr. GAY was a "fugitive" in the 'Wheel of Fugitive' episode of January 26, 2021 was false because Mr. Gay did not evade law enforcement.
51. DEFAMATORY EFFECT. The false statement had a defamatory effect, amounting to libel and defamation by implication, because the word 'fugitive' creates a false impression to the ordinary reader that Mr. GAY was eluding law enforcement, potentially dangerous, in need of apprehension, and was not trustworthy.
52. FAULT: IVEY intentionally identified Mr. GAY as a fugitive or was, at a minimum, negligent in publishing or causing to be published the false, defamatory statement because Mr. GAY's status as an inmate and his compliance with probation through the Florida Department of Corrections could have easily been known by IVEY.
53. MALICE OR ILL WILL. Additionally, because IVEY is part of Florida law enforcement and in control of the Brevard County Jail, the defamatory, false statement was made with malice and/ or ill will – arguably amounting to intentional misconduct and/ or gross negligence - because IVEY published it with knowledge of the falsity and/ or with reckless disregard for whether the statement was false or not.
54. DAMAGES. As the direct and proximate cause of IVEY's defamatory, false statement, Mr. GAY suffered damages including loss of potential employment; mental pain, anguish, and anxiety resulting in psychological analysis; and harm to his reputation that has caused him to be regarded with scorn, contempt, ridicule, and disrespect which will continue in the foreseeable future.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff Mr. GAY demands judgment against Defendant IVEY for compensatory damages, costs, interest as allowed by law, and for such other relief as the Court deems just and demands a trial by jury on all issues so triable as a matter of right.

**COUNT 2 –DEFAMATION**  
**AGAINST WAYNE IVEY**  
**(February 2, 2021)**

55. Mr. GAY adopts by reference, as if fully and completely set forth in this Count, paragraphs 1 through 45 herein.
56. STATEMENT OF FACT. On February 2, 2021, IVEY made a statement fact regarding Mr. GAY - to wit, that Mr. GAY was a “fugitive” – by use of Mr. GAY’s name and image and through written and verbal statements during an episode of IVEY and/ or BCSO’s ‘Wheel of Fugitive’ show.
57. PUBLICATION. On February 2, 2021, IVEY published or caused to be published the ‘Wheel of Fugitive’ episode depicting Mr. GAY to the general public on the internet through several outlets including YouTube and Facebook.
58. FALSITY. IVEY’s statement(s) that Mr. GAY was a “fugitive” in the ‘Wheel of Fugitive’ episode of February 2, 2021 was demonstratively false because Mr. GAY was in custody of the Brevard County Jail on February 2, 2021.
59. FALSITY. IVEY’s statement(s) that Mr. GAY was a “fugitive” in the ‘Wheel of Fugitive’ episode of February 2, 2021 was false because Mr. Gay did not evade law enforcement.
60. DEFAMATORY EFFECT. The false statement had a defamatory effect, amounting to libel and defamation by implication, because the word ‘fugitive’ creates a false impression to the ordinary reader that Mr. GAY was eluding law enforcement, potentially dangerous, in need of apprehension, and was not trustworthy.
61. FAULT: IVEY intentionally identified Mr. GAY as a fugitive or was, at a minimum,



negligent in publishing or causing to be published the false, defamatory statement because Mr. GAY's status as an inmate and his compliance with probation through the Florida Department of Corrections could have easily been known by IVEY.

62. MALICE OR ILL WILL. Additionally, because IVEY is part of Florida law enforcement and in control of the Brevard County Jail, the defamatory, false statement was made with malice and/ or ill will – arguably amounting to intentional misconduct and/ or gross negligence - because IVEY published it with knowledge of the falsity and/ or with reckless disregard for whether the statement was false or not.

63. DAMAGES. As the direct and proximate cause of IVEY's defamatory, false statement, Mr. GAY suffered damages including loss of potential employment; mental pain, anguish, and anxiety resulting in psychological analysis; and harm to his reputation that has caused him to be regarded with scorn, contempt, ridicule, and disrespect which will continue in the foreseeable future.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff Mr. GAY demands judgment against Defendant IVEY for compensatory damages, costs, interest as allowed by law, and for such other relief as the Court deems just and demands a trial by jury on all issues so triable as a matter of right.

**COUNT 3 –DEFAMATION**  
**AGAINST WAYNE IVEY**  
**(February 9, 2021)**

64. Mr. GAY adopts by reference, as if fully and completely set forth in this Count, paragraphs 1 through 45 herein.

65. STATEMENT OF FACT. On February 9, 2021, IVEY made a statement fact regarding Mr. GAY - to wit, that Mr. GAY was a “fugitive” – by use of Mr. GAY's name and image and through written and verbal statements during an episode of IVEY and/ or BCSO's ‘Wheel of Fugitive’ show.

66. PUBLICATION. On February 9, 2021, IVEY published or caused to be published the ‘Wheel of Fugitive’ episode depicting Mr. GAY to the general public on the internet through several outlets including YouTube and Facebook.
67. FALSITY. IVEY’s statement(s) that Mr. GAY was a “fugitive” in the ‘Wheel of Fugitive’ episode of February 9, 2021 was demonstratively false because Mr. GAY was in custody of the Brevard County Jail on February 9, 2021.
68. FALSITY. IVEY’s statement(s) that Mr. GAY was a “fugitive” in the ‘Wheel of Fugitive’ episode of February 9, 2021 was false because Mr. Gay did not evade law enforcement.
69. DEFAMATORY EFFECT. The false statement had a defamatory effect, amounting to libel and defamation by implication, because the word ‘fugitive’ creates a false impression to the ordinary reader that Mr. GAY was eluding law enforcement, potentially dangerous, in need of apprehension, and was not trustworthy.
70. FAULT: IVEY intentionally identified Mr. GAY as a fugitive or, was, at a minimum, negligent in publishing or causing to be published the false, defamatory statement because Mr. GAY’s status as an inmate and his compliance with probation through the Florida Department of Corrections could have easily been known by IVEY.
71. MALICE OR ILL WILL. Additionally, because IVEY is part of Florida law enforcement and in control of the Brevard County Jail, the defamatory, false statement was made with malice and/ or ill will – arguably amounting to intentional misconduct and/ or gross negligence - because IVEY published it with knowledge of the falsity and/ or with reckless disregard for whether the statement was false or not.
72. DAMAGES. As the direct and proximate cause of IVEY’s defamatory, false statement, Mr. GAY suffered damages including loss of potential employment; mental pain, anguish, and anxiety resulting in psychological analysis; and harm to his reputation that has caused

him to be regarded with scorn, contempt, ridicule, and disrespect which will continue in the foreseeable future.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff Mr. GAY demands judgment against Defendants IVEY for compensatory damages, costs, interest as allowed by law, and for such other relief as the Court deems just and demands a trial by jury on all issues so triable as a matter of right.

**COUNT 4 –DEFAMATION**  
**AGAINST WAYNE IVEY**  
**(February 23, 2021)**

73. Mr. GAY adopts by reference, as if fully and completely set forth in this Count, paragraphs 1 through 45 herein.
74. STATEMENT OF FACT. On February 23, 2021, IVEY made a statement fact regarding Mr. GAY - to wit, that Mr. GAY was a “fugitive” – by use of Mr. GAY’s name and image and through written and verbal statements during an episode of IVEY and/ or BCSO’s ‘Wheel of Fugitive’ show.
75. PUBLICATION. On February 23, 2021, IVEY published or caused to be published the ‘Wheel of Fugitive’ episode depicting Mr. GAY to the general public on the internet through several outlets including YouTube and Facebook.
76. FALSITY. IVEY’s statement(s) that Mr. GAY was a “fugitive” in the ‘Wheel of Fugitive’ episode of February 23, 2021 was demonstratively false because Mr. GAY was in custody of the Brevard County Jail on February 23, 2021.
77. FALSITY. IVEY’s statement(s) that Mr. GAY was a “fugitive” in the ‘Wheel of Fugitive’ episode of February 23, 2021 was false because Mr. GAY did not evade law enforcement.
78. DEFAMATORY EFFECT. The false statement had a defamatory effect, amounting to libel and defamation by implication, because the word ‘fugitive’ creates a false impression to the ordinary reader that Mr. GAY was eluding law enforcement, potentially dangerous,

in need of apprehension, and was not trustworthy.

79. FAULT: IVEY intentionally identified Mr. GAY as a fugitive or, was, at a minimum, negligent in publishing or causing to be published the false, defamatory statement because Mr. GAY's status as an inmate and his compliance with probation through the Florida Department of Corrections could have easily been known by IVEY.
80. MALICE OR ILL WILL. Additionally, because IVEY is part of Florida law enforcement and in control of the Brevard County Jail, the defamatory, false statement was made with malice and/ or ill will – arguably amounting to intentional misconduct and/ or gross negligence - because IVEY published it with knowledge of the falsity and/ or with reckless disregard for whether the statement was false or not.
81. DAMAGES. As the direct and proximate cause of IVEY's defamatory, false statement, Mr. GAY suffered damages including loss of potential employment; mental pain, anguish, and anxiety resulting in psychological analysis; and harm to his reputation that has caused him to be regarded with scorn, contempt, ridicule, and disrespect which will continue in the foreseeable future.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff Mr. GAY demands judgment against Defendant IVEY for compensatory damages, costs, interest as allowed by law, and for such other relief as the Court deems just and demands a trial by jury on all issues so triable as a matter of right.

**COUNT 5 –DEFAMATION**  
**AGAINST BREVARD COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE**  
**(January 26, 2021)**

82. Mr. GAY adopts by reference, as if fully and completely set forth in this Count, paragraphs 1 through 45 herein.
83. STATEMENT OF FACT. On January 26, 2021, BCSO made a statement fact regarding Mr. GAY - to wit, that Mr. GAY was a "fugitive" – by use of Mr. GAY's name and image

and through written and verbal statements during an episode of IVEY and/ or BCSO's 'Wheel of Fugitive' show.

84. PUBLICATION. On January 26, 2021, BCSO published or caused to be published the 'Wheel of Fugitive' episode depicting Mr. GAY to the general public on the internet through several outlets including YouTube and Facebook.
85. FALSITY. BCSO's statement(s) that Mr. GAY was a "fugitive" in the 'Wheel of Fugitive' episode of January 26, 2021 was demonstratively false because Mr. GAY was in custody of the Brevard County Jail on January 26, 2021.
86. FALSITY. BCSO's statement(s) that Mr. GAY was a "fugitive" in the 'Wheel of Fugitive' episode of January 26, 2021 was false because Mr. GAY did not evade law enforcement.
87. DEFAMATORY EFFECT. The false statement had a defamatory effect, amounting to libel and defamation by implication, because the word 'fugitive' creates a false impression to the ordinary reader that Mr. GAY was eluding law enforcement, potentially dangerous, in need of apprehension, and was not trustworthy.
88. FAULT: BCSO intentionally identified Mr. GAY as a fugitive or was, at a minimum, negligent in publishing or causing to be published the false, defamatory statement because Mr. GAY's status as an inmate and his compliance with probation through the Florida Department of Corrections could have easily been known by BCSO.
89. MALICE OR ILL WILL. Additionally, because BCSO is part of Florida law enforcement and in control of the Brevard County Jail, the defamatory, false statement was made with malice and/ or ill will – arguably amounting to intentional misconduct and/ or gross negligence - because BCSO published it with knowledge of the falsity and/ or with reckless disregard for whether the statement was false or not.
90. DAMAGES. As the direct and proximate cause of BCSO's defamatory, false statement,

Mr. GAY suffered damages including loss of potential employment; mental pain, anguish, and anxiety resulting in psychological analysis; and harm to his reputation that has caused him to be regarded with scorn, contempt, ridicule, and disrespect which will continue in the foreseeable future.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff Mr. GAY demands judgment against Defendant BCSO for compensatory damages, costs, interest as allowed by law, and for such other relief as the Court deems just and demands a trial by jury on all issues so triable as a matter of right.

**COUNT 6 –DEFAMATION**  
**AGAINST BREVARD COUNTY SHERIFF’S OFFICE**  
**(February 2, 2021)**

91. Mr. GAY adopts by reference, as if fully and completely set forth in this Count, paragraphs 1 through 45 herein.
92. STATEMENT OF FACT. On February 2, 2021, BCSO made a statement fact regarding Mr. GAY – to wit, that Mr. GAY was a “fugitive” – by use of Mr. GAY’s name and image and through written and verbal statements during an episode of IVEY/ BCSO’s ‘Wheel of Fugitive’ show.
93. PUBLICATION. On February 2, 2021, BCSO published or caused to be published the ‘Wheel of Fugitive’ episode depicting Mr. GAY to the general public on the internet through several outlets including YouTube and Facebook.
94. FALSITY. BCSO’s statement(s) that Mr. GAY was a “fugitive” in the ‘Wheel of Fugitive’ episode of February 2, 2021 was demonstratively false because Mr. GAY was in custody of the Brevard County Jail on February 2, 2021.
95. FALSITY. BCSO’s statement(s) that Mr. GAY was a “fugitive” in in the ‘Wheel of Fugitive’ episode of February 2, 2021 was false because Mr. GAY did not evade law enforcement.

96. DEFAMATORY EFFECT. The false statement had a defamatory effect, amounting to libel and defamation by implication, because the word ‘fugitive’ creates a false impression to the ordinary reader that Mr. GAY was eluding law enforcement, potentially dangerous, in need of apprehension, and was not trustworthy.
97. FAULT: BCSO intentionally identified Mr. GAY as a fugitive or was, at a minimum, negligent in publishing or causing to be published the false, defamatory statement because Mr. GAY’s status as an inmate and his compliance with probation through the Florida Department of Corrections could have easily been known by BCSO.
98. MALICE OR ILL WILL. Additionally, because BCSO is part of Florida law enforcement and in control of the Brevard County Jail, the defamatory, false statement was made with malice and/ or ill will – arguably amounting to intentional misconduct and/ or gross negligence - because BCSO published it with knowledge of the falsity and/ or with reckless disregard for whether the statement was false or not.
99. DAMAGES. As the direct and proximate cause of BCSO’s defamatory, false statement, Mr. GAY suffered damages including loss of potential employment; mental pain, anguish, and anxiety resulting in psychological analysis; and harm to his reputation that has caused him to be regarded with scorn, contempt, ridicule, and disrespect which will continue in the foreseeable future.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff Mr. GAY demands judgment against Defendant BCSO for compensatory damages, costs, interest as allowed by law, and for such other relief as the Court deems just and demands a trial by jury on all issues so triable as a matter of right.

**COUNT 7 –DEFAMATION**  
**AGAINST BREVARD COUNTY SHERIFF’S OFFICE**  
**(February 9, 2021)**

100. Mr. GAY adopts by reference, as if fully and completely set forth in this Count, paragraphs

1 through 45 herein.

101. STATEMENT OF FACT. On February 9, 2021, BCSO made a statement fact regarding Mr. GAY - to wit, that Mr. GAY was a “fugitive” – by use of Mr. GAY’s name and image and through written and verbal statements during an episode of BCSO’s ‘Wheel of Fugitive’ show.
102. PUBLICATION. On February 9, 2021, BCSO published or caused to be published the ‘Wheel of Fugitive’ episode depicting Mr. GAY to the general public on the internet through several outlets including YouTube and Facebook.
103. FALSITY. BCSO’s statement(s) that Mr. GAY was a “fugitive” in the ‘Wheel of Fugitive’ episode of February 9, 2021 was demonstratively false because Mr. GAY was in custody of the Brevard County Jail on February 9, 2021.
104. FALSITY. BCSO’s statement(s) that Mr. GAY was a “fugitive” in the ‘Wheel of Fugitive’ episode of February 9, 2021 was false because Mr. GAY did not evade law enforcement.
105. DEFAMATORY EFFECT. The false statement had a defamatory effect, amounting to libel and defamation by implication, because the word ‘fugitive’ creates a false impression to the ordinary reader that Mr. GAY was eluding law enforcement, potentially dangerous, in need of apprehension, and was not trustworthy.
106. FAULT: BCSO intentionally identified Mr. GAY as a fugitive or was, at a minimum, negligent in publishing or causing to be published the false, defamatory statement because Mr. GAY’s status as an inmate and his compliance with probation through the Florida Department of Corrections could have easily been known by BCSO.
107. MALICE OR ILL WILL. Additionally, BCSO is part of Florida law enforcement and in control of the Brevard County Jail, the defamatory, false statement was made with malice and/ or ill will – arguably amounting to intentional misconduct and/ or gross negligence -



because BCSO published it with knowledge of the falsity and/ or with reckless disregard for whether the statement was false or not.

108. DAMAGES. As the direct and proximate cause of BCSO's defamatory, false statement, Mr. GAY suffered damages including loss of potential employment; mental pain, anguish, and anxiety resulting in psychological analysis; and harm to his reputation that has caused him to be regarded with scorn, contempt, ridicule, and disrespect which will continue in the foreseeable future.

113. FALSITY. BCSO's statement(s) that Mr. GAY was a "fugitive" in the 'Wheel of Fugitive' episode of February 23, 2021 was false because Mr. GAY did not evade law enforcement.
114. DEFAMATORY EFFECT. The false statement had a defamatory effect, amounting to libel and defamation by implication, because the word 'fugitive' creates a false impression to the ordinary reader that Mr. GAY was eluding law enforcement, potentially dangerous, in need of apprehension, and was not trustworthy.
115. FAULT: BCSO intentionally identified Mr. GAY as a fugitive or was, at a minimum, negligent in publishing or causing to be published the false, defamatory statement because Mr. GAY's status as an inmate and his compliance with probation through the Florida Department of Corrections could have easily been known by BCSO.

127. Mr. GAY experienced severe emotional distress.

**COUNT 11 – RECKLESS INFLICTION OF EMOTIONAL DISTRESS**  
**AGAINST WAYNE IVEY**

128. Mr. GAY adopts by reference, as if fully and completely set forth in this Count, paragraphs 1 through 45 herein and the fact and allegations of Counts 1 through 8.
129. On or about January 26, 2021 through February 23, 2021, in Brevard County, Florida, IVEY'S conduct was extreme and outrageous.

130. IVEY'S conduct was reckless in that IVEY knew or should have known that emotional distress would follow by featuring persons on his 'Wheel of Fugitive' show including Mr. GAY.
131. IVEY's conduct caused Mr. GAY emotional distress.
132. Mr. GAY experienced severe emotional distress.


